

Annual Scholarships Awarded by Ocean Reef Conservation Association

The Ocean Reef Conservation Association annually awards four-year scholarships to graduating seniors in the Florida Keys that pursue degrees in the fields of marine and environmental studies. The scholarships are awarded taking into consideration educational achievement, career objectives, extracurricular activities, work

history, financial need and references. Successful applicants must maintain a 3.0 average GPA to retain the scholarship. Since 2010, the Ocean Reef Conservation Association has awarded over \$750,000 in partial scholarships to outstanding young women and men of the Florida Keys. The following graduating seniors were each awarded a \$16,000 scholarship: Allison Paskiewicz from Marathon High School who will attend Florida State; Katy Borders from Coral Shores High School will also attend Florida State; Allison Woltanski from Coral Shores High School will attend Georgetown University. In addition to the scholarship program, the Ocean Reef Conservation Association awards grants to nonprofits
